



## FEE & GRANT STRUCTURE AND REFUND POLICY

01 July 2017 to 28 June 2018

The fee structure of the programmes at 365 Haridwar, the International Artist Residency at AZIMVTH Ashram, is explained below. The currency used in this document is denominated only in USD, the United States Dollars.

### 1. NET FEE

NET FEE is the net applicable fee paid by applicants, with assumption that they apply for the two kinds of available grants – MERIT GRANT and NEED GRANT. Both of these grants are liberally available for all places at the programmes of 365 Haridwar. 365 Haridwar aims to encourage and work with every applicant to ensure that she/he is able to arrive at this NET FEE.

If number of days is other than the above quantum then the applicable fee can be arrived-at on a *pro rata* basis.

Stays for a period lesser than 7 days is by invitation only. Exceptional requests of stay for a period lesser than 7 days are handled on a case to case basis.

Residency for a period of 7 days or lesser than 14 days is generally meant for an artist who is already scheduled to participate with another residency programme in India or the region.

The main focus of 365 Haridwar is on the residencies for a period of 28 days or more.

### 2. STANDARD FEE

The STANDARD FEE is the discounted fee arrived at with discounts on the RACK RATE. The standard fee is without the MERIT GRANT and NEED GRANT. Applicants paying this fee get to stay in a private room with attached toilet and bathroom. This fee is mentioned below.

The RACK RATE (F) is for reference. Its amounts for various days viz. – 1 day / 7 days / 14 days / 21 days / 28 days are USD 100 / 700 / 1400 / 2100 / 2800 respectively.



### 3. GRANT STRUCTURE

Two kinds of grants are available to every applicant – MERIT GRANT and NEED GRANT. An applicant is encouraged to apply for both. If an applicant is awarded one or more kinds of grants then she / he is given a twin bed room with a possibility that if there is a need then another person of the same gender can also stay in the same room. In such a case, the fee is further reduced.

### 4. TWIN-SHARED FEE

Every room has two separate beds that may be joined. If two artists intend sharing the same room, then both of them have to complete and submit the Application & Grant Form. In such a case, a 20% SHARED DISCOUNT on the NET FEE is applicable. Hence, each of the two pays the TWIN-SHARED FEE. The TWIN-SHARED FEE is the fee arrived at by applying 20% SHARED DISCOUNT on the NET FEE. For clarity, the numbers are given below.

### 5. COMPASSION FEE

The COMPASSION FEE is applicable only if an applicant wishes to bring along a person with her because that person needs to be with the applicant. In that case, they will share the room. The COMPASSION DISCOUNT is 50% of the NET FEE. Hence, the COMPASSION FEE is half of the NET FEE and is payable by the second person. The main applicant still pays the NET FEE. The same application form is to be completed and submitted for both. While at 365 Haridwar, the second person should be involved with art in some way. For the sake of clarity, details are given below.

Both of them together pay the TOTAL COMPASSION FEE. The AVERAGED COMPASSION FEE is the average per person.

The COMPASSION FEE is applicable only if the person accompanying the main applicant belongs to one of the following kinds.

- child of age between 6 and 12
- retired person
- person with managed infirmity
- person with disability 365 Haridwar doesn't have a prior experience of receiving a person with disability. The premises have not be reviewed with a disability angle. Still, the largest room at the ground floor can be made available to an accompanied person with disability. Though nestled amidst forests, river, and mountains, Haridwar town is semi-rural. The terrain in the cluster is largely plain, except for the areas proximal to Ganges.

## 6. UNEMPLOYED PERSONS

Persons who are drawing unemployment allowance and on state support are eligible for the COMPASSION FEE.

## 7. REFUND POLICY

Selected applicants are expected to pay the complete fee within 30 days of offer letter. To reserve a place, at least 25% fee is to be paid. All of the fee is to be paid 90 days before the commencement of a residency. In absence of this, the offer-letter will stand cancelled and complete fee forfeited.

If after payment of the fee, a selected applicant is not able to attend a residency programme than he / she should write a note 90 days before the commencement of residency, explaining the reason why she / he is unable to continue with the programme. 75% of the fee can be refunded if a notice is given to '365 Haridwar' 90 days before the start of the residency programme.
