



## FEE & GRANT STRUCTURE AND REFUND POLICY

01 January 2019 to 28 June 2019

The fee structure of the programmes at 365 Haridwar, the International Artist Residency at AZIMVTH Ashram, is explained below. The currency used in this document is denominated only in USD, the United States Dollars. This document is subject to revisions from time to time. A participant may ask for the latest updated copy.

### 1. NET FEE

NET FEE is the net applicable fee paid by applicants, with assumption that they apply for the two kinds of available grants – MERIT GRANT and NEED GRANT. Both of these grants are available for all places at the programmes of 365 Haridwar. The grants are approved in full or partially. NET FEE is arrived at after accounting for the grants. An example is given below.

If number of days is other than the above quantum then the applicable fee can be arrived-at on a *pro rata* basis.

Stays for a period lesser than 7 days is by invitation only. Exceptional requests of stay for a period lesser than 7 days are handled on a case to case basis.

Residency for a period of 7 days or lesser than 14 days is generally meant for an artist who is already scheduled to participate with another residency programme in India or the region.

The main focus of 365 Haridwar is on the residencies for a period of 28 days or more.

### 2. STANDARD FEE AND RACK RATE

#### 2.1 STANDARD FEE

The STANDARD FEE is the discounted fee arrived at with discounts on the RACK RATE. The standard fee is without the MERIT GRANT and NEED GRANT. Applicants paying this fee get to stay in a room (shared with another person of the same gender) with attached toilet and bathroom. This fee is mentioned below.

## 2.2 RACK RATE

The RACK RATE (F) is for reference. Its amounts for various duration of residency are given below.

## 3. GRANT STRUCTURE

Two kinds of grants are available to every applicant – MERIT GRANT and NEED GRANT. An applicant is encouraged to apply for both. If an applicant is awarded one or more kinds of grants, in part or full, then she / he are allotted a bed room with 2 separate beds. A room is shared by 2 persons of the same gender. An example is given below.

## 4. SINGLE FEE (H)

An artist desirous of or needs a room all by herself / himself can make such a request and still apply for both of the MERIT GRANT and NEED GRANT. A SINGLE PREMIUM (G) of 20% will be applicable on the NET FEE. An example is given below.

## 5. COMPASSION FEE

The COMPASSION FEE is applicable only if an applicant wishes to bring along a person with her because that person needs to be with the applicant or vice-versa. In that case also, they will share the room. A COMPASSION DISCOUNT of 50% of the NET FEE will be applicable. Hence, the COMPASSION FEE is half of the NET FEE and is payable by the second person. The main applicant still pays the NET FEE. The same application form is to be completed and submitted for both. While at 365 Haridwar, the second person should be involved with art in some way. An example is given below.

Both of them together pay the TOTAL COMPASSION FEE. The AVERAGED COMPASSION FEE is the average per person.

The COMPASSION FEE is applicable only if the person accompanying the main applicant belongs to one of the following categories.

- child of age between 6 and 12
- retired person who is financially dependent on the main applicant
- person with managed infirmity
- person with disability - 365 Haridwar doesn't have a prior experience of receiving a person with disability. The premises have not been reviewed with a disability angle. Still, a room at the ground floor can be made available to an accompanied person with disability. The private bathroom attached to this room has a sloping access and the door has been designed to easily accommodate a wheel-chair. Though nestled amidst forests, river, and mountains, Haridwar town is semi-rural. The terrain in the cluster is largely plain amenable to a wheel-chair, except for the areas proximal to Ganges.

## 6. NET PAYABLE FEE

The NET PAYABLE FEE (L) is the final amount of the invoice arrived at after all considerations.

## 7. UNEMPLOYED PERSONS

Persons who are drawing unemployment allowance and on state support are not eligible for the COMPASSION FEE.

## 8. REFUND POLICY

A selected participant reserves a place by making a payment of the 50% of the NET PAYABLE FEE within 14 days of the date of the offer letter. The balance 50% is paid by the participant not later than 06 months before the start of the residency date.

The Refund Policy is applicable only if a participant intimates about refund no later than 06 months before the start of residency.
